### 2 COGNITIVE SKILLS RESOURCES


Before we go into detail, first here is a list of the main cognitive skills resources you can take advantage of on the Teacher Portal.

- Review self-directed learning cognitive skills questions. View


## 3 ASSIGN COGNITIVE SKILLS LESSONS

Next, click on Ceate session to begin setting up an online cognitive skills lesson. Extra information and steps are provided during setup.




Once your lesson is created it will appear in this table. Select a lesson from the table to access the following features:


- Mark responses / Review marking / View results

### 4 PRESENT CLASSROOM READY COGNITIVE SKILLS LESSONS



### 6 REVIEW SELF-DIRECTED LEARNING COGNITIVE SKILLS QUESTIONS

All students with an active cognitive skills subscription have access to self-directed cognitive skills questions via the student portal – this can be accessed via the Cognitive Skills tab.

To review a student's work, navigate to the Cognitive Skills section on the teacher portal. Click on Track and then from the drop down menu, select Self-directed cognitive skills questions. Now select a student and you will be able to view a list of cognitive skills questions attempted by them and their responses.
