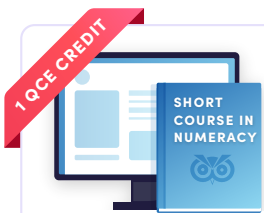
About our courses

Each course has been designed as resources to supplement the teaching of the existing QCAA courses (in Literacy, Numeracy, Careers and Skills for Work). Students and teachers will access the courses via the Mighty Minds portal. Each course can be integrated into your student's workday, homework schedule or used as additional resources to support learning.



Short Course in Literacy

This course will provide students with the basic literacy skills needed to overcome barriers in contemporary post-school life. Student's will advance their knowledge of the four core skills – reading, writing, oral communication and active learning by completing activities over two comprehensive topics and associated assessment.



Short Course in Numeracy

This course provides students with numeracy skills that are needed to navigate post-school life. Student's will advance their knowledge of two core skills – numeracy and active learning – by completing activities over two comprehensive topics and associated assessment.



Steps to the Future (Short Course in Careers)

This course is designed to help students pave their own pathways in life, focussing on their future education, training and careers. Students work through four carefully crafted chapters based on the QCAA Career Education Short Course Syllabus (2018).



Skills for Work

This course focusses on pathways to employment, further training and other vocational pathways as well as literacy and numeracy for the workplace. Students will be upskilled in employability and given the opportunity to develop their own learning plan to suit their future career. The Skills for Work resources are aligned to the Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways (FSK20119).
